## **Principal's Report**

## COVID

- Things are starting to relax with Covid restrictions
- Asking families to continue screening in morning using the provincial screening tool which is to be accessed through OPH
- When student has one tier one symptoms assumed to be Covid
- When student has one second tier symptom isolate for 24-48 hours
- We're able to send home 2 more RATs with students needed if needed
- We still have limited number of PCR tests but being limited to hospital use
- Used to be a lot of contact tracing and case management but we've now switched to optional self-reporting
- Our ventilation system is top notch there's been no known transmission within the school

#### **New Guidelines**

- Now allowed to engage in group work for a short period of time
- Intramurals for Grade 7-12 within grade cohort only

- We're allowed to start to use parent/committee volunteers to support student learning
- It will be possible to use volunteers for outdoor field trips and other opportunities
- Any volunteers must have completed vaccine attestation
- We're allowed to have outdoor field trips can't use buses but can walk and the destination must be outside
- Hoping cohorting will be relaxed soon
- Integration of students of Specialized Program Classes
- Continuing to complete daily staff screening and confirmation

#### Staffing

- Continuing to experience staff shortages, but we're strictly following district protocol
- We have had to close classes a few times
- We try to close classes for older students vs younger students
- Whenever we close classes, it happens in close consultation with the Superintendent
- In order to avoid class closures, Stuart and Rebecca have been taking over all different positions lunch monitor, ECE, EA, and teaching
