The Role of School Council

All schools in Ontario have a school council. They are important advisory bodies to the schools and school board. The purpose of a school council is, through the active participation of parents, to improve student achievement and increase accountability of the education system to parents.

Effective school councils are those that:

- prioritize student achievement, equity and well-being
- focus on the needs and interests of all students in the school
- are composed of members who represent the diversity of the board
- promote effective, ongoing communication among all partners in education
- establish a positive, respectful relationship with the school principal and staff
- provide feedback to parents by letting them know how their advice and ideas have been considered
- have a clear understanding of their roles and responsibilities
- have a clear and consistent process for decision making and conflict resolution
- maintain high ethical standards

Some Suggestions

If you have a concern, please, contact your child's teachers and the principal directly. For example, any particular student details with respect to behaviour and disciplinary action are confidential - and just as any parent would not want other parents to speculate about an incident that took place at school that involved their child, we need to preserve the dignity of all our students and maintain confidentiality.
